Mr MacIsaac

Please let me introduce myself as the new President of Nasittuq. I have tried to call you on a few occasions but unfortunately you were out of the office. I will try to call you again this coming Friday.

Firstly, I do knowledge receipt of your letter about the correspondence with the Nunavut Water Board.

I would like to point out that we seem to have given you the wrong impression about our intentions. We wanted to express to the Water Board the fact that the initial licence applications that were submitted in 2003 had requested the permit to burn "authorized garbage" and that as such we did not have the capacity to incinerate on site (except for one location).

Secondly, I was extremely disappointed to find out that we had unfortunately disposed of HazMat in an inappropriate fashion. This was particularly frustrating to us given that we have the procedures and means to dispose of this material in the proper way. We have re-issued strict guidelines to all our staff and reminded them of the importance of complying with existing rules and regulations. In addition, I want to reassure you that we will comply with the licence and implement all the necessary steps to demonstrate how we will do so. We have also been working with Col Ward and his staff to demonstrate how we will comply with the instructions your staff has given to DND.

In review your response, I note that you refer to a **Note on incineration from the Nunavut Government's Department of Environment in Conjunction with Environment Canada**. I seek your assistance in locating this document as it would allow us to determine what would be the best technical solution for some of the sites where we will not use local municipal facilities. This information will help us in completing the applications for the new licences as quickly as possible.

I really would like to work with you and your staff to make sure we are a model corporate citizen.
