Thank you for the April 4, 2023 invitation to review the response to comments for the annual report submission, submitted by Fisheries and Oceans Canada - Small Craft Harbours (DFO-SCH), for Type B Water Licence No. 8BC-CLY2225.

CIRNAC examined the application pursuant to its mandated responsibilities under the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* and the *Department of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Act*. CIRNAC is satisfied with DFO-SCH's response and has no further comments.

Outside of these is this question we direct back to you to address with the proponent. This is a direct quote from DFO-SCH in their reply to CIRNAC "DFO-SCH would also like to confirm if conditions in the NWB-Type B licence apply to marine environments? The dredge spoil pile is directly adjacent to the proposed harbour in Patricia Bay, and should not influence freshwater."
