Good afternoon Dionne,

I have done some tracking of the Meadowbank mar shalling area at Baker Lake as requested by Kevin, and found that the area was within the screening and review conducted by NIRB. The Proponent had requested to have it screened separately, but the Board declined this request. In correspondence of October last year, the Board incorporated Cumberland's commitment to monitoring discharge from the mar shalling area sump into the Terms and Conditions. The Board also required Cumberland to develop a monitoring plan specific to the BL Mar shalling Facility area, and that the water use and waste management plans for the BL facility be incorporated into the final design and engineering phase.

Condition 12 of the Project Certificate states:

*Cumberland shall provide details of a comprehensive water use and water management plan for the Baker Lake mar shalling area, including monitoring of the discharge from the mar shalling area sump, in the water license application to the NWB.*

Additionally, the original application and project description submitted to NIRB indicate that the bulk storage of fuel was a part of the project.
