## **Introduction**

This Abandonment and Restoration Plan has been prepared for the Arviat Diamond Driller's Training program operated by the Hamlet of Arviat and includes the proposed training program to be carried out. The program is not an exploration project but is designed to provide trainees with hands-on experience working on a diamond drill.

The drilling program will take place at approximately ( 61 ° 05 ' 60 " N) ( 94 ° 03 ' 37" W)

The abandonment and restoration of the drill sites will be completed upon the completion of each drill hole.

## **Final Abandonment and Restoration Plan**

### Fuel Storage

At the end of the project, the double walled sloop tank will be removed from the field training area. Any drums will be removed from the site and disposed of.

Any unused oil or grease will be returned to Arviat.

### Drilling Areas

The drills will be dismantled and removed to Arviat. All drill sites will be inspected for contamination. Any remaining waste will be returned taken into the Arviat landfill for proper disposal.

Drill sites will be restored immediately after the drill has been moved.

Any soil contamination by hydrocarbons will be treated as per the spill contingency plan.

Sumps used for containment of drill effluent will be located in topographic depressions and well away from water bodies such as rivers, lakes and ponds. Once a drill hole has been terminated, the sumps will be filled in.

### Documentation and Inspection

Photos of the drill sites will be taken before and after restoration.

The permit holder will organize a final site inspection with Land Use Inspectors.
