Following a complete administrative and technical review the following documentation is required to complete your application:

1. Drawings of locations of geotechnical boreholes and potential borrow areas. Identified as attached to your submission but not received.
2. Stand-alone spill contingency plan that should contain at least the following elements:
  - a) a title page
  - b) date prepared and effective period
  - c) page numbers
  - d) table of contents
  - e) brief introduction on the project
  - f) an NT-NU spill report form
  - g) contact numbers for INACs Manager of Field Operations, GN-DoE, NT-NU 24 hr spill line, DFO, EC and Project Manager (office and on-site)
  - h) measures to prevent and contain spill on land, ice, and in water
  - i) a detailed site map depicting the area encompassed by the project including fuel caches, staging areas, water bodies and any other relevant information
  - j) types and amount of various chemicals stored on site; and
  - k) relevant MSDS sheets
3. A stand-alone abandonment and restoration plan (A&R Plan) that addresses the following issues, at least:
  - a) title page
  - b) date prepared and effective period
  - c) page numbers
  - d) table of contents
  - e) brief introduction
  - f) work schedule or work plan
  - g) list of equipment and infrastructure associated with the project and plans for dismantling and removing them from the site; and
  - h) measures to clean up the restore affected areas on completion of the drilling

program

4. State the average distance and direction from the nearest community where the drilling program is to be carried out.
5. Water use fee of \$30.00 which is payable on an annual basis, on the anniversary of the issue of the licence
