Dear Stephan Kerr:

Please be advised that Section 12.7.1 (b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) states:

*"a recommendation of Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) pursuant to a 12.4.4 (a) may provide for the establishment of a monitoring program for that project which may specify responsibilities for the proponent, NIRB or Government."*

Further, Section 12.7.3 (a) of the NLCA states:

Without limiting the generality of Section 12.7.2, the monitoring program set up pursuant to that section may include:

*"a requirement that regulatory agencies and the proponent supply NIRB with reports and information respecting project operations and impacts, and the implementation of mitigative measures."*

According to the terms and conditions contained in the NIRB's Screening Decision Report on February 18, 2013, for the "Iqaluit Hydro-Electric Baseline" Project Proposal, Qulliq Energy Corporation is to submit an Annual Report to the NIRB and Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. At this time, the NIRB

has not yet received Qulliq Energy Corporation's annual report for the "Iqaluit Hydro-Electric Baseline" for the 2013 reporting period.

Qulliq Energy Corporation is advised to refer to the terms and conditions issued within the Screening Decision Report (attached) regarding the submission of your Annual Report. NIRB is requesting this information by **November 17, 2014**.
