Any future planned activities will require renewal applications for the Water License and any Land Use permits issued previously for this activity.

Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada's Field Operations Unit is in the process of risk-prioritizing all projects receiving Federal Authorizations within the Nunavut Territory.

This includes all Water licenses, Land Use Permits, Leases and Quarry Permits issued by either the Nunavut Water Board or Aboriginal Affairs.

AANDC will use the results generated by this process to facilitate inspection planning for the upcoming 2015 field season.

AANDC asks that Licensee's to fill out the attached Project Assessment Check for each project you are operating in the Baffin Region and return it within 30 days. If you completed one of these forms in 2014 please update any new information on the enclosed 2015 form adding any new authorizations or noting any closures/ Cancellations or renewals that have taken place over the last year.
