RE: Required letter for license application regarding financial responsibility

Dear Mr. Dwyer:

This letter is in regard to three proposed water crossings to be built near Sanikiluaq, as part the Anuriqjuak Nukkiksautiit project, which will see electricity in Sanikiluaq produced by a wind turbine, and reduce by nearly half the amount of diesel fuel used in the community for electric generation.

The water crossings, as described in the license application, involves an upgrade of an existing trail to become an all-weather road to access the wind turbine. It will involve installing three permanent culverts of 500mm - 1000mm diameters, to allow water to continue to flow under the road. The ownership of the road and the culvert will eventually be transferred to the hamlet.

Until then, Nunavut Nukkiksautit Corporation will be the owner and assumes financial responsibility for the water crossings.
