Support Letter for Access Road Ownership— NNC Anuriqjuak Nukiksautiit Project

Representatives of Nunavut Nukiksautiit Corporation (NNC), who are near the beginning of the construction phase of the Anuriqjuak Nukiksautiit Project for Sanikiluaq, discussed with council the ownership takeover of the 5km long access road. This road will be an upgrade to an existing trail that will be used to transport the cranes and large turbine parts for construction to its designated location as well as the installation of a transmission line. Following the construction, the road will be used as access to the turbine and transmission line for maintenance.

Once the construction of the access road is complete, Council is in agreement that Council will takeover ownership of this road indefinitely. A condition of this agreement is that Council will not be responsible for maintenance of the road such as snow clearing or grading when required. Periodic repairs to the road and its infrastructure will be controlled by the NNC or its representatives for the life of the Project, and only for the purpose of maintenance and inspections of the Project equipment.

On behalf of the Council, I would like to confirm that we fully support this project and offer our best regards to the NNC and their representatives during the construction and operation stages.

Dear Shelly:

We have carefully assessed the risk and reviewed all provided documentation supporting the Anuriqjuak Nukkiksautiit Wind Turbine Project proposed for Sanikiluaq including Transport Canada's Aeronautical Assessment # 2023-18. We have also carefully considered guidance concerning Wind Turbines & Wind Farms as outlined in Transport Canada publication TP1247E "Land Use in the Vicinity of Aerodromes".

Based on our review of the proposed Sanikiluaq Wind Farm Project, falling outside, but in close proximity, to lands covered under the Sanikiluaq Airport Zoning Regulations SOR/2012-92, we assess the operational and safety risks posed to CYSK resulting from the Project to be low, hence we have no objections at this time.

Finally, should there be any project changes going forward that may alter our assessment I ask that we be advised at your earliest.
