**Crown Land Application  
Project Description  
Bathurst Inlet Port and Road Project**

We acknowledge receipt of your application for crown land along with your project description for the Bathurst Inlet Port and Road Project. In reviewing the package you submitted and the project description we have decided to that we are unable to process the application in its present form as it is lacking detailed information (maps and drawings) that allows us to properly locate the land you are applying for. In addition, the Bathurst Inlet Port & Road Joint Venture does not appear to be a legal entity registered at Nunavut Legal Registries, Department of Justice, Government of Nunavut. A recent check with them has found that you are not yet registered at their office. In order for a company to lease land in Nunavut you must be registered as a legal entity at the Nunavut Legal Registries.

Finally, as your project is for several different uses, we will require separate land applications for the different uses and tenure we will be issuing on crown land.

We acknowledge that you admit that the project description is lacking in several areas at this stage of the process, however in order to accept and process an application for crown land we do require information to cover several key areas. We suggest you address the following points and forward us the necessary information before we accept the applications for processing;

1. You must become registered as a legal entity at Nunavut Legal Registries before we can accept your applications for leases and licence. You can contact them at 867-975-6190. Their mailing address is Nunavut Legal Registries, P.O. Box 1000, Station 570, Iqaluit, Nunavut, X0A 0H0.
2. We require separate land applications for the different uses you are proposing. We suggest you submit the following applications for crown land;


- a) application for lease, water lot, Bathurst Inlet dock site.
- b) application for lease, land portion, Bathurst Inlet dock area.
- c) application for lease, main camp area, Bathurst Inlet site.
- d) application for lease, tank farm area, Bathurst Inlet.
- e) application for lease, airstrip site, Bathurst Inlet.
- f) application for lease, bed of body of water, Contwoyto Lake, barge sites
- f) application for licence, Road from port to Contwoyto lake and from Lupin to Izok, Crown land portion only.
- g) At this stage we will not require the land use permit and quarry permit applications for each of your proposed quarries on crown land. However, in order to confirm locations of these sites we require 1:50,000 scale maps showing the proposed locations of the 22 quarries on crown land.
- h) All of the applications for lease must include a plan at the appropriate scale showing the parcel of area being applied for. Dimensions of the parcels must be shown and should also include a location map at a 1:50,000 scale at least.
- i) The applications for licence (road) must include maps at a 1:50,000 scale that will allow us to clearly define what portions of the road are on crown land and give us reasonable certainty on the route location.

We do not feel it is appropriate to reject your application at this time, however, we do not yet have the minimum amount of information to accept them and forward them to NIRB for review. The application you submitted to us was a photocopy of the application and not the original. Please submit original applications to us along with the appropriate application fee for each application. We are returning your application fee of \$160.50 (cheque no. 000157) to you unprocessed.

Please note that if the original applications and fees along with the requested information outlined above are not received within 45 days of the date of this letter we will have no alternative but to return your request to you unprocessed.
