
Dear Ms. Ikkutisluk:

At your request, the Department of Culture and Heritage, Government of Nunavut, has reviewed the above-noted application. Our recommendations follow.

The Government of Nunavut presently has limited information about the nature and density of archaeological resources in the study area. As a result, we recommend that prior to any disturbance activities, archaeological site assessments be conducted in all areas impacted as a result of the land use activities. The results of these assessments will allow the developer and the Government of Nunavut to ensure that archaeological resources are not inadvertently damaged or destroyed.
