Hello Cathy,

I have reviewed your attachments.

You do not require a Land Use Permit for purposes of a road construction/repair since you are not seeking to "occupy" the land. So that application (and permit) can simply be ignored.

In regards to the Quarry Permit Application, you must also complete and submit the **Project Proposal Application** which I had sent to you (it is attached here, once again). This document is also mandatory and will be submitted to NIRB for the usual screening.

I emphasize, once again, that you must specify and provide the specific coordinate descriptions of the proposed sites (on both application forms) before your application can even be considered or processed.

You may forward your cheque (payable to the Government of Nunavut) to this office for the total fees involved.
