Hi Phyllis,

We have now completed the Cape Christian Clean up Project (initial reason for needing a road) and demobilize all equipment back to Clyde River, and therefore the road to Cape Christian will not be required by us anymore. We had discussions with the Hamlet to eventually assign the license and that is the main reason we initially applied for a renewal. However, it was recently decided to retrieve our Water Licence renewal application, and leave the hamlet of Clyde River apply for their own License if they wish to maintain the road. We came to this conclusion after 2 consecutive summer of intensive work to build a sustainable road to leave to the community and concluding that the lack of proper gravel material in the surrounding area impeded our efforts. This being said, we understand this does not release QC from any obligations imposed by the existing License that expired October 1, 2010. We have conducted some mitigation work during this summer for which we will report. Otherwise, we will be planning to complete all mitigation work and remove all water crossing in the summer of 2011 to comply with all requirements of the License.
