RECORD OF CONVERSATION

Date: Monday October 18, 2010, 12:30pm MST

Parties: Karlette Tunaley on behalf of the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) and Philippe Simon on behalf of Qikiqtaaluk Corporation (QC)

Subject: Renewal Application for 8BW-CLY0810

Karlette contacted Philippe via telephone to clarify the QC's intentions for renewing water licence 8BW-CLY0810 which expired on October 1, 2010. The conversation was in follow-up to an email chain between Phyllis Beaulieu, NWB Manager of Licensing, and Philippe Simon, Subject: 101015 8BW-CLY0810 - Requirement for submissions, dated October 15, 2010.

Philippe indicated that at the time of submission of the renewal application in September 2010, QC anticipated that the water licence for the road from Cape Christian to the Hamlet of Clyde River would be assigned to the Hamlet once QC had completed the remediation project at Cape Christian. Now that the remediation at Cape Christian is complete, QC prefers that the Hamlet apply for their own water licence if they wish to maintain the road. Therefore, QC has decided to complete abandonment and restoration of the road in 2011, leaving the bridge in place.

Karlette advised Philippe that QC requires a valid water licence to conduct the proposed abandonment and restoration work. Otherwise, the Inspector of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada may find QC in contravention of the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* and *Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* for the deposit of waste without a licence. Karlette also informed Philippe that if QC did not require any amendments to the water licence such as the need to develop additional borrow sources, the renewal application would not require screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board.

Philippe agreed to inform Phyllis Beaulieu that QC would continue with the process of renewing the water licence.
