On May 19, 2011 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Qikiqtaaluk Corporation’s “Road between Clyde River and Cape Christian – Road Abandonment Activities” project proposal from the Government of Nunavut Department of Community and Government Services (GN-CGS).

All documents received and pertaining to this project proposal include:

- *NIRB Part 1 Form in English*
- *Non-technical Project Proposal summary in English*

The NIRB has undertaken a preliminary completeness check and finds that Qikiqtaaluk Corporation’s project proposal does **not** contain sufficient information for the NIRB to permit proper screening. Specifically, the NIRB is requesting submission of the following information by **June 8, 2011**:

- *Non-technical Project Proposal summary in Inuktitut.*
- *Reasoning for change in the end-use of the road infrastructure, including answers to the following, if not evident in reasoning provided:*
 - *Why is the road now planned to be decommissioned?*
 - *Was the original intent upon project completion to leave the road intact for use by local residents?*
- *Records of public consultation on the proposed road decommissioning project, if any.*
- *Abandonment and Restoration Plan (should include, but is not limited to: all methods of erosion control, dust suppression, contouring, and re-vegetation of lands).*
