The NWB is aware that the NIRB issued a screening decision for the Swan Lake River Bridge project on September 9, 2015.

As a reminder, to proceed with your Water Licence Application you are required to provide a Spill Contingency Plan for the project. Also, your communication with the NIRB indicates that construction of the Bridge is scheduled to occur in the FY 2016-2017. The Water Licence Application requests a licence term of one (1) year (September 2015 to September 2016). Do you wish to extend the requested licence term on your application?
