Dear Peter,

On July 09, 2015, the NWB received a Water Licence Application from the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven for the construction of a bridge crossing on Swan Lake River (attached).

The project falls outside of an area with an approved Land Use Plan, however, the NWB recognizes that since the implementation of NuPPAA all project proposals must first be screened by the NPC before proceeding to the water licensing stage.

Saying this, the NIRB provided its screening decision for the undertaking on September 9, 2015 (attached), which also stated that the NIRB's assessment of the file began November 17, 2014--well before NuPPAA came into effect.

As such, recognizing that the determination of the extent to which NuPPAA applies to a given project remains with the NPC, the NWB requests that the NPC review the project proposal as outlined in the Application and provide the Board with its determination regarding whether this activity constitutes a project under NuPPAA.
