Hi,

A Spill Contingency Plan should contain at least the following:

- 1) Plan title page, table of contents introduction, description of the site, inventory of facilities including fuel and chemical storage;
- 2) Name, address and title of person in charge;
- 3) Site map showing all components; of suitable scale (ie 1:1000 or 1:10,000);
- 4) Steps outlined for reporting/containment/cleanup and response;
- 5) How the plan is activated;
- 6) Inventory and location of equipment and supplies;
- 7) Training
- 8) Copy of the NWT Spill Report Form
- 9) Date Plan was prepared and the effective period
- 10) Material Safety Data Sheets provided, current of 3 years;
- 11) Spill kits on site: number, location and contents;
- 12) fuel storage inventory;
- 13) Emergency contact list for assistance and information (to include INAC, EC, DFO, GN)
