Hello Simon

With respect to the renewal application for Licence 8BW-IGD1516, while we wait for your submission of the executive summary in Inuktitut, I have a couple of points of clarification to address.

1) Can you please comment on and confirm that the plan for road construction is the same as was originally proposed for the Licence, i.e. the source of granular materials for road construction remains the trail area deposit, and the total number of culverts to be installed to support drainage remains the same at 11 for small water crossings (<5m)?

a. Correct, there are 11 crossings in total. However, we had flagged 3 water crossings which are potentially wider than 5m depending on the elevation of the spring runoff. The crossings were intended to be highlighted as per below (in the application as well).

2) Can you provide an updated Spill Response and Erosion and Sediment Control Plan, that includes the updated regulatory agency names and contact numbers, as well as updates to project specific contact names and numbers.

a. See attached.

3) Please note that the Licensee is required to submit annual report under condition B1 of the Licence, even if no work is conducted. This was not completed under the previous Licence. If a renewal Licence is granted please ensure this is done. If again the project does not go forward, this can simply be indicated in the annual report submitted.

a. Understood, we will ensure the City of Iqaluit is aware of this requirement.

4) Can you provide the specific date when work proposed to begin and end?

a. The intent is to potentially start in the summer/construction season of 2019. The construction activities would shut down for the winter months and resume (or commence) during the 2020 construction season again and finish before December 2020.

5) When can we expect the summary in Inuktitut?

a. See attached.
