A. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 15, 2015, the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) provided notification to interested parties that the City of Iqaluit had submitted a new application for Type 'B' water licence to construct two stream crossings that are needed for the construction of an access road to a new municipal quarry.

Interested parties were requested to review the information and provide comments by February 15, 2015

B. RESULTS OF REVIEW

The City of Iqaluit should notify an Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada Water Resource Officer at least 10 days prior to the construction/installation of any stream crossing.
