A. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 2, 2015 the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) provided notification to interested parties that the City of Iqaluit had submitted a change of scope to the application for Type 'B' water licence to construct additional water crossings that are needed for the construction of an access road to a new municipal quarry.

Interested parties were requested to review the information and provide comments by March 13, 2015

B. RESULTS OF REVIEW

AANDC has no comments for the additional water crossing to the construction of an access road to the new municipal quarry. However AANDC's previous comments made in a technical review memorandum dated February 16 2015 still apply.

The City of Iqaluit should notify an AANDC Water Resource Officer at least 10 days prior to the construction/installation of any stream crossing.
