Dear Mr. McLean:

The Nunavut Water Board (“NWB”) acknowledges receipt of your new application for a Type “B” water license on April 11, 2006 for water use and waste disposal associated with the Pullalik Bridge Project in the Qikiqtani region of Nunavut. All documents received, and pertaining to the application, can be obtained from our ftp site (<http://ftp.nunavut.ca>) in “nwb / 8BW-PUL. They include the following:

- cover memo, undated, received April 11, 2006
- water license application form, received April 11, 2006
- description of project, English and Inuktitut, received April 11, 2006
- supplemental technical information, received April 11, 2006
- application fee, water use fee, received April 11, 2006
- photos and diagrams, received April 11, 2006
- map of area, received April 11, 2006
- additional information and diagrams, received May 10, 2006

We undertook a preliminary review of your application and conclude that it meets the requirements of section 48(1) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* (“Act”). This said, I must inform you that the NWB reserves the right to request additional information and studies pursuant to sections 48(2) of the Act or, alternatively, issue guidelines for the provision of information pursuant to section 48(3) of the Act.

The NWB Technical Advisor assigned to your application may be in touch with you to clarify any technical details related to your application.

This application is within an area where there is no land use plan approved in accordance with Part 5 of Article 11 of the NLCA, and is therefore not subject to the requirements of Section 38 (1) to 38 (5) of the Act.

Finally, by copy of this letter to the distribution list and the enclosed notice of application sent to the council of the municipality or municipalities most affected by your application, we invite interested persons to make representation directly to the NWB **within 30 days from the date of this letter.** The NWB may provide additional procedural instructions once the application has been reviewed by interested parties.
