On August 15, 2011 the Nunavut Water Board provided a written response from Nunami Stantec to a technical review memo that was provided by the Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada's (AANDC) Water Resources Division on May 8, 2011 concerning the above- referenced application. Nunami Stantec responded on behalf of the Hamlet of Repulse Bay.

The submitted response satisfactorily addresses the comments/ recommendations outlined in the AANDC technical review memo. These pertain to having a stand alone spill contingency plan for this endeavor, culvert sizing, culvert alignment, general drainage culverts, and reclamation. Appropriate technical expertise was used to prepare the response.

Nunami Stantec's commitments to reclaiming all borrow pits in accordance with AANDC's *Northern Land Use Guidelines: Pits and Quarries* is an appropriate and prudent measure. In addition, the AANDC Water Resources Division recommends that the Licensee submit an abandonment and reclamation plan for the access road and all borrow sources. This plan should address progressive and final closure measures.
