Thank for your support and your help in the review process.
Below the answer to your questions:

- The Spill Contingency Plan and Remote Camp Questionnaire cover a different undertaking than the Application. The former documents cover an undertaking planned for 2014 near Igloolik, while the latter covers an undertaking planned for the northeast of Ellesmere Island in 2015. The Remote Camp Questionnaire indicates that your research is a multi-year project; as such, is your current Application for an extension to a project that began in 2014? If so, did you possess a previous Approval WL or Licence with the NWB?

This a mistake from my part; sorry about this (since we also applied for Igloolik this year, I may have forgot to correct for this in the application for Ellesmere) . The current application is indeed only for the current year and for the camp site on north Ellesmere.

- Under block 3 of the Application, you wrote "Unorganized Land" as the owner of the land. What exactly do you mean by this?

We wrote this because it was not an Inuit own land, nor a federal one, nor within a community border. Is the term territorial land more appropriate in this case? I am not sure.
