I am the Technical Advisor working on this file, after file review, the conclusion is that more information is required for the following:

### Blocks 10 &11 of the Application

1) How many persons are expected to be at the camp site?

### Block 12 of the Application - Table

2) Clarify measures to avoid or mitigate impacts from the sewage and the greywater. The listed mitigation measures are considered not enough.

3) other wastes (i.e. solid wastes)

Recommended measures are:

Greywater and toilet waste shall be directed to pits and covered.

Recommend measures for solid -non combustible waste is backhaul

The waste must not be deposited to surface waters or within 31 m of the ordinary high water mark of any body of water.

Note that not use of water or deposit of waste is authorized unless the conditions under the Nunavut Water Regulations are complied with.
