The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

- 1. Production of aggregate, hauling and stockpiling of aggregate at the Hall Beach Airport. All aggregate is coming from the hamlet quarry. Activities will involve pumping less than 50 m³water per day.
- 2. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [Hall Beach Airport]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan and is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB).
