The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal. The works and activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by the NPC, including scientific research activities, and a conformity determination

was issued most recently on 7 May 2023 which still applies. In addition, associated activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB File No. 03YN010).

This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPPAA)* under Section 235 of that Act.

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the *Nunavut Agreement* do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. This conformity determination applies only to the above-noted project proposal as submitted.
