> go, please be advised that there are guidelines in place to be
> followed:

> Guideline for the Burning and Incineration of Solid Waste, revised

> January 2012;

> - Environment and Climate Change Canada, Open Burning of Garbage

> Brochure, dated 2010; and

> - Canadian Council of Ministers of the Environment, Guidance

> Document for Canadian Jurisdictions on Open-Air Burning, dated 2016.

> As for annual reports, I am attaching last year's approval for your

> project. For such approvals, the requirement is a bit different than

> for licences in the sense that you are not required to submit a

> report if you have another approval or licence for the same project:

> "The Authorized Entity need not submit the report referred to in Item

> 8 (c) if the Authorized Entity obtains a new approval authorizing a

> use of Water or deposit of Waste without a licence, or a licence

> authorizing a use of Water or deposit of Waste for the same

> undertaking on the same site within thirty (30) days after the last

> day of the period previously authorized".

>

> The contents for a report are outlined in the Approval.

>
