The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

Scientific Research: The general objective of this project is to document direct and indirect impacts of
climate change on tundra ecosystems, and forecast future impacts on these populations and the Arctic
landscapes in which they occur. The specific goal is to monitor the abundance and distribution of
arthropods, small mammals, plants, arctic-nesting birds and terrestrial predators on Igloolik Island (Nunavut,
Canada).

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal.
