Please find attached a completed application to the Nunavut Water Board for approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a license.

The project this application covers involves scientific research into the breeding ecology of light-bellied brant geese. This is a collaborative project between scientists from the UK, Ireland and Canada. As part of this research we propose establishing a temporary fieldcamp (comprising personal tents and a mess tent) on the Schei Peninsula, Axel Heiburg Island for a period of approximately one month in the summer of 2014. This fieldcamp will enable us to follow the feeding habits and survival of goslings in detail, and will form part of our wider research into the complete annual migratory cycle of these birds.
