The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal and has determined that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The works and activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC most recently on 21 October 2020, including non-invasive photography, water and ice sampling, and video monitoring of eiders. In addition, the associated activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB File No. 10YN058).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the *Nunavut Agreement* do not apply.
