TITLE: Impacts of Melting Tidewater Glaciers on Marine Biogeochemical Cycles

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

We propose to characterize the biogeochemical impact of glacial runoff and meltwater plumes on a regionally productive marine ecosystem that is central to the health of indigenous communities. Our proposed field work program for 2019-2024 will be completed on the Sverdrup Glacier, Belcher Glacier, Sydkcap Glacier and Jakeman Glacier, and their downstream marine environments. This project is designed to thoroughly characterize and quantify the material exports from the glaciers, define their environmental controls, and assess their impacts in downstream marine environments. We have assembled a team of new and established Canadian researchers capable of characterizing the physical, biological and chemical properties of subglacial water, from its meltwater origin, through its transport along the glacier bed, and finally to its discharge into and dispersion within the ocean.
