The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

 Scientific Research: Investigate the bedrock geology of an underexplored areas of the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut. Field works includes ground-based walking traverses, collecting small rock samples, and acquiring non-destructive measurements with a hand-held geophysical instrument. Approximately 15-30 rock samples of 1-2 kg each will be collected, using hammer and chisel, in order to investigate the rock samples origin and chemical composition through laboratory analysis.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.
