
Map showing 2019 proposed sites for palenontology research, Strathcona Fiord, Ellesmere Island, Nunavut



The sites in red are on Inuit Owned Land.

One site is our proposed camp site with jet-B fuel cache. We would like to camp here for four nights.

The other site is the Beaver Pond site.

The blue polygons are other proposed sites that are outside the Inuit Owned Land, between Strathcona Fiord and the east side of Vendom Fiord. We will stay at Fyles Leaf Bed site (FLB) for 8 nights. We will visit the other sites briefly this year. If they are potentially useful for paloentology study, we will request to return in a future season.
