Background: Nunavut Water Board Approval Without a Licence 8WLC-LEP1617, issued to John Charles Gosse, Department of Earth Science, Dalhousie University, allowed for the use of 1 cubic metre of water per day, and the deposit of greywater and sewage. This authorization expired on July 17, 2017 and supported the camping activities at the Paleontology and Paleoecology of the 3-million year Old Sediment Project, Strathcona Fiord, Ellesmere Island at approximate GPS co-ordinates of 78.484078°N and 82.635744°W.			
Inspectors Statement On July 2 nd 2017 an inspection was conducted at the general location of the camp facilities to inspect any uses of water or deposits of waste as authorized.			
Water Use: No uses of water observed at the time of inspection.			
Waste Disposal: No deposits of waste were observed at this site or the surrounding area at the time of the inspection.
