The primary focus of research undertaken at the research station is related to the perennial springs that occur near the camp, the springs research and the research station are covered under land use permit N2006N0028 (extension in progress) and multiyear research licence No. 02 052 10R-M (approved for 2010).

Please appreciate that the requirements put on researchers wishing to work in the Nunavut have become very confusing and that the majoring of university scientists struggle to make sense of the process.
