Subject: Licence Application for Netilling Lake Project

Dear Mr. Leafloor:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") would like to acknowledge receipt on July 11, 2008 of an application for a new water Licence 3BC-NET. The application has undergone a preliminary-technical review and a number of issues with the application have been identified that require a response:

1. The remote camp questionnaire states under 'Camp Location' question 9 that a map is included with the application, however no map is attached. Please provide a map of the camp showing all buildings, fuel storage, latrine pit(s) and water sources;
2. Please clarify who the Licence should be made out to; if the research is being conducted for Environment Canada and the Canadian Wildlife Service then those name(s) should be the name(s) on the Licence;
3. The Licence application states that the completion date is to be August 31, 2008 but the remote camp questionnaire states August 20, 2013. Please clearly state the completion date for the research; and,
4. The application did not include a spill contingency plan. All applications require such a plan and should be in the format set out by the *Consolidation of Spill Contingency Planning and Reporting Regulations R-068-9*.

At this time, the NWB is unable to process the application further without the information requested above. Once all the information is provided, the application will be deemed complete and the renewal process can proceed with a thirty (30) day distribution of the application for review and comment by interested persons.
