Good morning Marc:

I have reviewed your file and provide the following information. Based on the amount of water authorized you would qualify for an approval without a licence. However the 3BC-NET0913 file will require closure by the AANDC Inspectors, therefore my recommendation would be to continue with a type B application for renewal at this time.

Currently there appears to be Inspection issues relating to clean up by the proponent. As well, our office has no record of receiving any annual reports for 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013 (attached is a copy of the last AANDC inspection conducted on the project area.

In accordance with Part H, Item 1 of the terms and conditions of the attached licence, there was a requirement to submit a revised Spill Plan addressing several issues. To date the revised plan has not been received. As part of the renewal I would suggest submission of the revised plan, for approval.

In accordance with Part I, Item 1 of the terms and conditions of the attached licence, there was a requirement to submit an Abandonment and Restoration Plan. This also, has not been received.
