Hi Richard,

Thanks for getting back to us so quickly. The NIRB informed us that they are having delays this summer, and confirmed that our work previously screened can begin without delays. They are currently screening our operations planned for Leg 4 and 5 in the Queen Elizabeth Islands and in Foxe Basin, which are identified by the NPC as significant modifications.

Our work on Eastern Baffin Island therefore falls under our last NIRB screening, conducted in 2017 (see attached, amendment to 06YN071). I also took the liberty of including last year's NPC screening decision and this year's screening decision for more context.
