New application for approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence for the DRDC Northern Watch Technology Demonstration Project

Dear Phyllis,

On behalf of Defence Research and Development Canada (DRDC), Defence Construction Canada is requesting approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence at the Gascoyne Inlet site for the Northern Watch Technology Demonstration (NWTd) Project.

This project previously had a Type B Water Use Licence, 1BR-NWT1113 which expired September 30, 2013. Rationalization for this change in licencing can be found in the *Nunavut Waters Regulations SOR/2013-69*; Schedule 2 – Column 1, 'Any undertaking other than power undertaking'; Column 2 (4), 'Any other use of water'; Column 3, 'Use of less than 50 m³ per day'.

The DRDC NWTd Project uses; less than 1 m³ per day of water, all sewage is transported off-site to an approved sewage lagoon, and greywater is screened and returned to the land via a loose gravel surface.
