Re. New application for approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence for the DRDC Northern Watch Technology Demonstration Project

On behalf of Defence Research and Development Canada (DRDC), Defence Construction Canada is requesting approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence at the Gascoyne Inlet site for the Northern Watch Technology Demonstration (NWTDT) Project.

The DRDC NWTDT Project uses; less than 1 m³ per day of water, all sewage is transported off-site to an approved sewage lagoon, and greywater is screened and returned to the land via a loose gravel surface.

The DRDC NWTDT Project will entail of Gascoyne Inlet camp and research activities, the Recovery of Northern Watch array, deployment of Maritime Autonomous and Remotely Piloted Systems (MARPS) and Long Range Acoustic Transmission (LRAT) activities.
