Our company (Bathurst Inlet Developments (1984) Ltd) has a camp located at Pellatt Lake, NU.

The camp/buildings has been in place for over 15 yrs. We have a Federal land lease and in the past were not required to have a water license to operate. We did however have regular inspections and the camp was always found to run in accordance with Federal Inspectors requirements.
