

Yes, you could submit your application before the NIRB makes decision, however, the NWB will not formally process it until NIRB makes its decision.

I am assuming that the confusion happened because all information were submitted to the NWB before NIRB decision. Although we are cc-ed generally with NIRB decisions, however, to avoid any delays I will recommend you to advise the licensing or Robin who will be working on your file once you get the NIRB decision.

Hi Karén,

Thank you for your response.

Yes, I already submitted our application for the camp to NPC. I am aware of the streamlining of the application process, that needs to go through NPC first.

But I would still need to submit a separate application to NWB, am I correct?

OK, I will submit the application to the licensing@nwb-oen.ca address.

Should I do it only after we receive a decision also from NIRB?

NWB will likely forward the application after two weeks at most. But NIRB will need a much longer time to reach their decision, sometimes around two months.

As for last year's application, I sent it twice to many email addresses at NWB (including yours, if I remember correctly). Please find it attached. It was not returned with an "undeliverable" message, so I assumed that it arrived to the addressed inboxes.

It was sent mid-April, after NPC reached their decision, and while the application was under NIRB's review.

We received NIRB's decision mid-May.

Also, you may be aware that due to recent regulatory changes in Territory all project proposals should be first reviewed by Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) and possibly by Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB).
