

For a period of ~ 3 weeks, a team of 10 geologists will perform helicopter-assisted ground traverses and collect small (hand-sized) rock samples. Two people will use a helicopter to take stream sediment samples and till samples. Operations will be based from a temporary field camp at the Ellice River, 65°50'58N 105°19'24''W (same location as in 2014). The camp will be completely dismantled and cleaned prior to the end of the field season. Land use timeframe including erection and dismantling of temporary field camp will be approximately from June 24 to July21, 2016.
