RE: NPC File # 148593 [Supply of Water to the Nunavut Brewing Company Limited]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted proposal:

- 1. Pump water from the Sylvia Grinnell River and transport it to the tanks at brewery using a water truck. No structure or access road is being constructed road.
- 2. Associated NPC File No: 148163 Water Extraction for Iqaluit Craft Brewery
- 3. Location: Qikiqtani Region; Iqaluit within municipal boundary; Sylvia Grinnell River.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this proposal falls within the exemption of certain works and activities from the definition of the term "project" under the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (*NUPPAA*) and from the definition of the term "project proposal" under the *Nunavut Agreement* because the NPC is of the understanding that it will be carried out entirely within a municipality and does not have ecosystemic impacts outside the municipality and does not involve the deposit of waste by a municipality, the bulk storage of fuel, the production of nuclear or hydro-electric power or any industrial activity. The NPC only has a statutory

mandate to review "projects/project proposals". As such, the proposal is exempt from a review by the NPC and a screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB).
