Background

On August 23, 2021 Water License 8WLW-WAG2122 was issued to Combustion Performance Inc. For the Approval for Use of Waters Without a License. Authorizing the water use not to exceed 15m³ per day. Effective August 23, 2021, expiring August 22, 2022.

Inspector Statement

On August 24, 2021 a water license inspection was conducted by Water Resource Officer (WRO) Joseph Monteith to verify compliance with 8WLW-WAG2122.

Inspection

Water Use

- 1. Water is withdrawn from Dead Dog Lake (photo 1) and Carney Creek.
- 2. Water License observed on site at the time of the inspection (photo 2).
- 3. Water Usage Logs Observed onsite at the time of the inspection. Each log date states 1000 Litres. Dates in log run contrary to Subsection 11(1) of the Nunavut Waters, and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (photo 3,4,5).
- 4. Withdrawn water is stored in a Water Storage Tank (photo 6)
- 5. Water is withdrawn using a Mobile Water Pump (photo 7)

Deposit of Waste

- 6. 3x pails observed on site. Each pail is roughly 8 to 12 Litres is used to wash vehicles. The raw water mixed with soap run off from the cleaned vehicles is the deposit of waste (photo 8).
- 7. No concerns for deposit of waste, as site of cleaning is over 31 metres from any water body.



After having received confirmation from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC)² that the Applicatio falls outside of an area with an approved land use plan, and, as such, a conformity determination is not required and is exempt from the requirements for screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRE as described within s. 12.4.3 / Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement, the Board is satisfied that the requirements of Articles 11 and 12 of the Nunavut Agreement and sections 3 and 4 of the Nunavut Wate Regulations (NWR or Regulations) have been adequately addressed. In addition, through the provision a signed Application for an Approval Without a Licence, the Applicant has agreed to adhere to section 4(3), 5(4), and 6(1) of the Regulations and to comply with the associated requirements, the NW determined that:
